The African Development Bank (AfDB) was established in 1964 to promote economic and social development in Africa. It moved its permanent headquarters in Abidjan, Côte D'Ivoire to its temporary headquarters in Côte D'Ivoire, Tunis, Tunisia, following the outbreak of civil war.

In 2006 AfDB awarded Teknion Furniture Company of Ontario, Canada, the contract to furnish and outfit its new regional offices.
